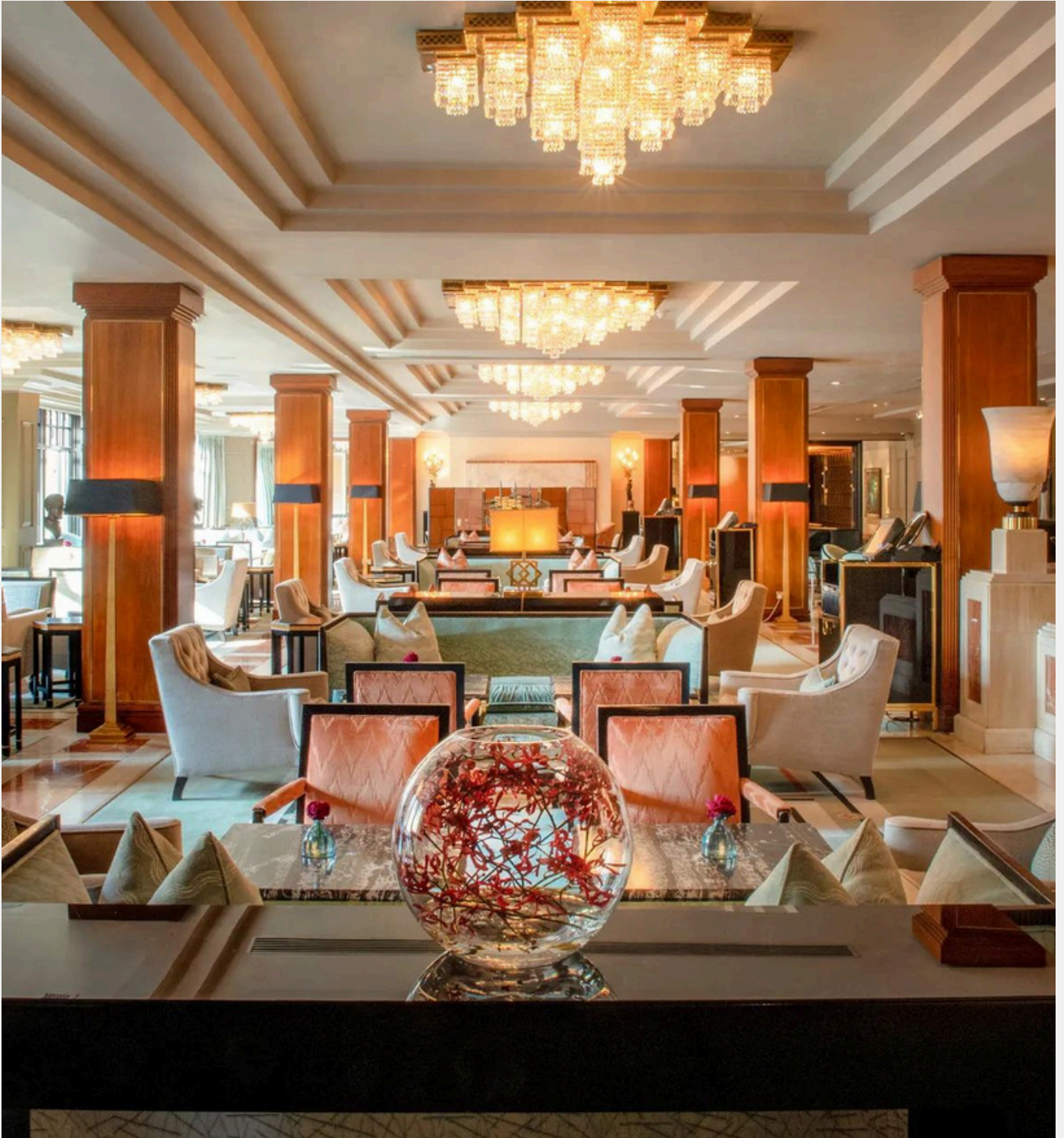
ITINERARY HIGHLIGHTS
